When it comes to national junior breed associations, each has a different set of rules about ownership. Any 4-Her interested in showing beyond the local level is **STRONGLY** encouraged to read the respective breed association rules for ownership and leasing. *Breeds might require additional paperwork to be completed PRIOR to the shows.*

For state fair entries, animals must have proof of ownership 60 days PRIOR to Ohio State Fair. Please refer to state fair rules.

Junior Ownership/leasing rules are as follows:

Animals may be owned solely by the junior exhibitor or in a partnership provided the junior exhibitor's name appears on the registration papers, prior to August 1. **THIS IS FOR NATIONAL SHOWS.**

The recorded date, not the delivery date, will be considered the transfer date. Registration papers will be checked at the show. In lieu of ownership, a lease agreement will be acceptable. An approved lease of a 4-H, state, or FFA program must be recognized and verified at the National Ayrshire Office by August 1. If a lease program is not available in your state, a form can be obtained from the National office.
